- 2017- Participated in campaign to help defeat troublesome zoning ordinance.
- 2018 Joined coalition to defeat tax surcharge for home health services referendum.

- •2017 Negotiated a lower VRAP fee increase and cap on fees, and lower fee increases for State Fire Plan review.
