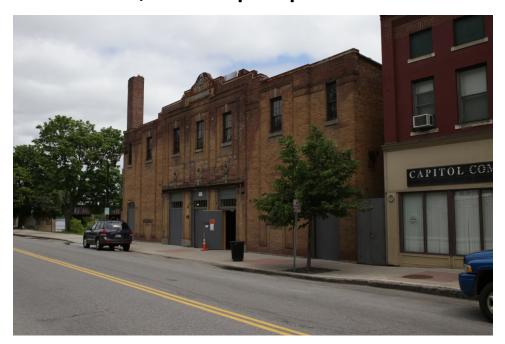






Restoration of Augusta's Colonial Theatre

 Possible location of a new DHHS facility





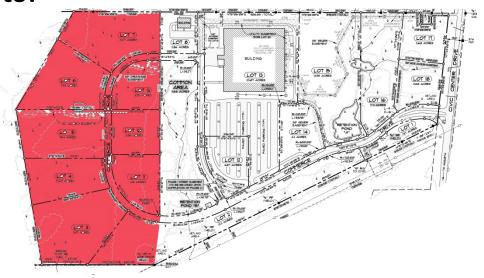
Stevens Common - Hallowell
