

Public Policy Update

MEREDA's Public Policy Committee continues to stay engaged on critical matters impacting our members.

LD 772, Bill to Improve Permitting Predictability, Heads to Governor for Final Approval

LD 772, An Act to Limit Retroactive Application of Land Use Ordinances to Pending Permit Applications that Propose Housing, has been finally enacted in the House and Senate and is now headed to Governor Mills' desk for her final approval. We expect the Governor will sign the bill into law, and the law will take effect 90 days from the date of



- LD 772 will improve permitting predictability in Maine by **prohibiting a municipality from enacting a retroactive ordinance that would apply to a pending land use application.** Once an application has been deemed complete, it will be reviewed based on the land use ordinances and rules in place at that time.
- As a final compromise to get the bill over the line, MEREDA agreed to a requirement that the land use project **must have a housing component.**
- Housing creators and advocates, land use planners, and community planning organizations can now **rely upon land use planning**, including the goals set forth in the comprehensive plan. The comprehensive plan and ordinance approval processes involve significant public input, and parties should be able to rely on those efforts.

MEREDA identified a need to address retroactive ordinances following the defeat of a planned 900-unit project in Kittery in 2022. That project, like others, have fallen prey to empowered NIMBYs seeking to limit housing creation. This policy loophole ignores the state's interest in protecting and promoting land use planning to encourage certain municipal activities, including housing creation.



In 2011, MEREDA worked to improve predictability by establishing a cut-off date by which an issued permit could not be modified or nullified by retroactive action. That provision, at 30-A MRSA §3007(6).

This year, MEREDA is proud to have led the effort to close the loophole altogether and ensure the predictability of land use planning.

MEREDA wishes to thank Senator Matt Pouliot for his steadfast efforts and sponsorship of this bill. We also thank and appreciate the work of the housing committee for its efforts to advance housing policy in Maine that is fair, practical, and predictable – mirroring MEREDA's own guiding principles.

Joint Select Committee on Housing Recommends Permanent Joint Standing Committee on Housing

The Joint Select Committee (JSC) on Housing will dissolve when the 131st Legislature adjourns. However, so much work remains to be done to create adequate housing in the state that the current committee has recommended to the next legislature that it adopt housing as a stand-alone permanent committee. Prior to this legislature and JSC, the Labor and Housing Committee had jurisdiction over all housing related matters. Given the scope of work that remains to be done, MEREDA hopes that the 132nd Legislature will heed the advice of the JSC and move to permanently give housing its own committee.

Dollars for Development more!

The current proposal for the 2024-2025 Supplemental Budget would include:

- \$22 million to support the Rural Affordable Rental Housing Program, the Low-Income Housing Tax Credit Program, and to expand affordable rental and ownership housing options.
- \$5 million to establish a manufactured and mobile home park preservation and assistance program.
- \$16 million for the Emergency Housing Relief Fund program to establish programs to assist the needs of people experiencing homelessness.
- \$171,437 to establish the Office of Community Affairs, which will serve as a one-stop shop for municipalities to help them navigate housing, climate preparedness, immigration, clean energy, recycling, and other transitional policy matters. The Office of Community Affairs has been referred to by some as the State Planning Office 2.0 because, though housing and land use is only one of its duties, it is an area where resources for municipalities have been sorely lacking for over a decade.

MEREDA will continue to remain diligent in protecting its members' interests. Our members represent a critical pillar of the state economy, and we will continue to advocate for policies that are fair, practical, and predictable.
